Sunday May 29 - **Post 692's Memorial Day Ceremony**, 2:30PM at the Bender JCC in Rockville - 6125 Montrose Road, Rockville, MD 20852. There will be guest speakers, music, a wreath laying, and a bugler.

Monday May 30 - **Annapolis Memorial Day Parade**

- The parade involves about a mile of marching and then standing for a short ceremony (about a half hour). If you cannot march the whole way or stand that long in the ceremony, just do what portion you are comfortable with. There will be one Jeep on which we mount the flags (US and JWV Post) that can take up to three participants who want to participate but cannot walk (plus the driver).
- Uniform will be white short sleeved shirt (polo or button down), dark (preferably, black) pants, black shoes, JWV cap (or equivalent veteran headgear).
- All those wishing to participate should muster in the Congregation Kneseth Israel parking lot (1125 Spa Rd, Annapolis, MD 21403) at 8:45 AM. We will move from there to the staging location at Amos Garrett Blvd (across from Westin hotel) and the actual parade starts at 10am (so better to show up late than not at all). We are normally the first group in the line after the Naval Academy Band as we are the oldest Vet organization.
